Vice-Chairman Gene Harrell began the meeting at 5:00 p.m.

Mr. Harrell stated that public comments can be made at any time in the meeting prior to action on any agenda item upon which a vote is to be taken.

Moved by Secretary/Treasurer Greg Nolan, seconded by Commissioner Joe Boudreaux to approve the minutes of September 16, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Commissioner Dale Dennis, seconded by Commissioner Chris Domangue to approve the accounts payable report. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Commissioner Francis Richard, seconded by Commissioner Dale Dennis to approve the finance report. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Dustin Rabalais reported that only 3 pumps are operational and running.

Mr. Rabalais reported that the Bayou operations are normal.

Mr. Rabalais reported the updates to the Pump Capacity Improvements Project (PCIP).

Mr. Eric Dalamore with Stantec, gave a presentation on the PCIP progression.

Mr. Rabalais discussed Change Order #4 and asked for its approval.

Mr. Rabalais gave an update on the Phase 3 Permitting/Design.

Mr. Rabalais announced that a public hearing will be held at the November 18, 2024 meeting to adopt the proposed 2025 general fund budget, and proposed 2025 PCIP budget and reviewed the budget summaries.

Mr. Rabalais discussed a permit variance for the City of Thibodaux Canal Street Bridge Replacement and recommended its consideration.
